# STOP TRUMP'S WARS



The world is careering towards catastrophe. From Trump's assault on Venezuela, to his threats on Iran, Greenland, Cuba, Colombia and elsewhere.

Yemen, Syria and Lebanon continue to bear the brunt of US imperialism. Ukraine has been caught in the crosshairs of a geopolitical game driven by the US and NATO, making the war longer and bloodier than it might otherwise have been.

Britain's involvement in the US war machine is extensive. The UK gave military support for US piracy in the Atlantic, when American troops boarded a Russian-flagged tanker, risking direct conflict with Russia. US bases in Britain are used as launchpads for military attacks, and the proposed return of US nuclear warheads to these shores is alarming.

Trump's announcement of a 50% increase in military spending – when the US already spends more than Iran, Russia and China combined – indicates his intention to use war and threats of war to achieve his goals.

Appeasing Trump at every turn, European leaders have responded with a war-drive of their own – a continent-wide rearmament programme at vast cost, and the reintroduction of conscription.

Working people need welfare not warfare. We cannot afford to accept war driven austerity. The TUC's 'wages not weapons' resolution and its strong condemnation of Trump's attacks on Venezuela indicates growing opposition to the war agenda. We must build on this anti-war sentiment.
