At the same time, billions more are being directed towards the military, NATO and the arms industry while the NHS, schools and public services face chronic underfunding.

Trade unions have a proud history of standing for peace, international solidarity and the interests of working people. At a moment of rising militarism and global instability, that voice is critically important.

By affiliating to the Stop the War Coalition, trade unions can strengthen the movement against war and militarism. Your support helps expand campaigning, organise meetings and demonstrations, and take the anti-war message into workplaces and communities across the country.

At a moment of growing international tension, we need a mass movement capable of challenging war and demanding peace. Trade union support will be decisive in building it.



"The first victims of this illegal war were 160 little Iranian girls, killed in their primary school on the first morning of the week. And we have to ask where is international law? We're told there's no money for the NHS, for schools, or for transport but there always seems to be money for bombs. So the message to the government is simple: focus on welfare, not warfare. Keep Britain out of this illegal war, and focus on fixing problems at home."
