STOP TRUMP'S WARS



The world is once again being pushed towards catastrophe.

At the end of February, the US and Israel launched major military attacks on Iran, triggering a dangerous regional war, with a renewed offensive on Lebanon as well as Gaza. The conflict has already killed hundreds, including schoolgirls in Iran, and is already spreading across the Middle East, threatening millions of lives.

Trump's aggressive foreign policy has escalated tensions across the globe – from Venezuela and Cuba, to Greenland, Iran and beyond. Instead of diplomacy, the strategy is threats, sanctions and military escalation.

Across the Middle East, ordinary people continue to pay the price. Yemen, Syria, Lebanon and Gaza have all suffered the devastating consequences of years of war and intervention.

Britain's involvement in the US war machine is extensive. American bases in Britain are used as launchpads for military operations, and the UK government continues to align itself closely within Washington's war agenda.

Trump's push for massive increases in military spending, when the US already spends vastly more on its military than any other country, shows that war and threats of war remain central to US foreign policy.

At the same time, European leaders are responding with a war drive of their own, expanding military budgets and pushing for continent-wide rearmament, with the reintroduction of conscription possibly on the cards.

Working people need more welfare, not warfare. We cannot afford endless war abroad whilst public services are cut at home. The trade union movement has begun to speak out, with the TUC calling for wages not weapons and growing opposition to the politics of militarism.

A stronger anti-war movement is urgently needed. Join the fight back, become a member, join a local group and get your trade union to affiliate.
